Project Description

2. On-Site Rehearsals & Productions

Support instructors during rehearsals and workshops. Help out at backstage during performances and collect feedback post-event.

Training typically encompasses soft skills development, covering essential areas like conflict resolution, effective workplace communication, and fostering empathy. These invaluable skills are imparted by seasoned professional coaches, ensuring a comprehensive and enriching learning experience.

Are there any stipends for the programme?

A stipend of HKD \$1,500 will be awarded to students who complete ALL parts of the programme including satisfactory performance in the 5-week internship and attending all training sessions.
